Having heard Mr. Rana Mukherjee, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioners for sometime and appreciating the argument that different Division Benches cannot arrive at different conclusions, we are yet of the view, having perused the judgment dated 17.03.2020, and its aftermath, the impugned Circular dated 03.06.2020, which is the subject-matter of challenge in the present petition, that the reasoning contained in the 17.03.2020 Division Bench judgment is correct in that the Rules namely, 17, 18, 19 & 21 do not say anything about eligibility of candidates.

This being the case, we do not interfere with the impugned judgment under Article 136 of the Constitution of India.

The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.
