Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

The office report records that the respondent is duly served, but none appears for the respondent.

The petitioner is the wife and the respondent is the husband. At present, the petitioner-wife is a resident of Panipat, Haryana. The respondent-husband is a resident of P.S.Bahadurpur, P.O.Mahendru, District Patna, Bihar. The respondent-husband has filed a petition for restitution of conjugal rights before the Family Court at Patna. The prayer in this petition is for transfer of the said petition to the Family Court at Panipat, Haryana. The distance between the place of the residence of the petitioner and the Court at Patna is about 1100 k.m. There is no contest by the respondent.
