2. We have heard learned counsel Ms. Saubhagya Sundriyal for the

appellant(s)/petitioner(s)/State and learned counsel for the respective respondents.

3. During the course of submission, Shri Rishabh Sancheti, learned counsel for the respondent(s) drew out attention to the fact that in the case of State of Rajasthan & Ors. Vs. Paras Kanwar (SLP (C) .. CC No. 4709/2013), by order dated 04.03.2013, this Court declined to interfere in the matter. He submitted that the impugned order(s) of the High Court in all these cases pertain to the police officers, who have been killed during the course of performance of their duties. Therefore, they are entitled to special pensionary award under Rule 268-I of the Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951.

4. Having regard to the fact that this Court has already dismissed the Special Leave Petition(s) filed by the State of Rajasthan and others by declining to interfere with the order of the High Court, we follow the said order and dismiss these petitions/appeals also.

5. Insofar as the case of respondent/Madhu Bala is concerned, the concerned police official was returning home after completion of her duty. Hence, we apply the doctrine of notional extension and dismiss the said appeal (C.A. No.489/2018) also.
