Leave granted.

The impugned Judgment and order of the High Court dated 09.06.2020 wrongly records that an iron rod was recovered from the present appellant, who is Accused No. 12. We have been shown from the Recovery Memo as well as from the Chargesheet that this is incorrect. The learned counsel appearing for the State also fairly submits that the High Court is not correct.

This being so, the basis for non-grant of bail, particularly when all the other co-accused have been released on bail, goes. The net result is that the impugned Judgment is set aside.

We were also told by the learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant was wrongly released, but has since been taken into custody. That will not affect the position insofar as this order is concerned.

In view of the above, the appeal is allowed.
