O R D E R

- 1 By the impugned order dated 28 May 2020 the learned Single Judge of the High Court of Punjab & Haryana noted the pendency of Transfer Petition (Crl)

Nos 613-616 of 2019 before this Court in which an order has been passed on 27 November 2019 staying proceedings in the FIR. The learned Single Judge in the circumstances felt that “a debatable issue arises” as to whether the High Court would lose seisin over its jurisdiction to decide the application for bail.

- 2 Notice was issued on the Special Leave Petition on 14 August 2020. The State of Punjab has entered appearance through Standing Counsel.
- 3 We clarify that the High Court is at liberty to hear and dispose of the application for bail.
- 4 The Special Leave Petition is accordingly disposed of.
