The Supreme Court Mediation Centre has filed a report dated 3rd April, 2018 to the effect that the parties have settled their disputes and differences under the auspices of the Mediator, Ms. Vanita Mehta.

The settlement agreement has been signed by both the parties as well as their respective advocates.

Both the parties are present before us. It is requested by both the parties that the divorce by mutual consent may be granted in terms of the settlement agreement. Various cases filed by both the parties may be withdrawn/quashed being:

(i) FIR No.61/2017 under Sections 498A lodged in Women Cell, Bikaner, Rajasthan arising out of Case No.993 of 2017 pending before the Court of JM-3, Bikaner District Court, Rajasthan filed by the Petitioner-wife.

(ii) Case No.315 and 316 of 2017 under Section 125 Cr. PC, filed by the Petitioner-wife before the Family Court II, Bikaner, Rajasthan.

(iii) HMA Case No.64/2017 under Section 13(a) of Hindu Marriage Act, seeking divorce from the Petitioner filed by the Respondent-husband in the Family Court Dwarka, Delhi.

Looking to the facts of the case, in exercise of our powers under Article 142 of the Constitution, we dissolve the marriage between the parties.

The transfer petition is accordingly disposed of.
