UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

By the impugned judgment and order, the High Court has released the private respondent No.2-herein on bail in connection with Case Crime No. 625 of 2019, for the offence punishable under Section 409 IPC, Police Station Sigra, District-Varanasi.

Since the last 2-3 occasions, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has remained absent. Today also, when the

matter was called, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Though the order passed by the High Court releasing the private respondent No.2 on bail can be said to be a non-reasoned order, however, considering the allegations in the complaint, it can be seen that the main allegation is against one Saurabh Rai, co-accused, in the facts and circumstances of the case, the order passed by the High Court releasing the private respondent No.2 herein on bail is not interfered with. The Special Leave Petition stands dismissed. However, it is observed that the learned trial Court to proceed further and decide and dispose of the trial in accordance with law and on its own merits and without in any way being influenced by the observations made by the High Court while releasing the respondent on bail and/or by this Court while passing the present order.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
