A deliberate attempt is being made to hoodwink this Court into thinking that Annexure P1 is Exhibit P1. Annexure P1 is a cheque of the same date for a sum of Rs.9 lakhs in favour of one C. R. Ramanna signed by one M. Linya issued on Vijaya Bank; the

cheque number is 415033. As opposed to this, the cheque which was the subject matter of the proceedings is the cheque drawn on Bangalore Bank of the same date and the same amount but whose number is 442092.

We do not appreciate such tactics on the part of the petitioner. The special leave petition is dismissed with Rs.50,000/- as costs to be paid to the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today.
