

seven days time to the petitioner to present himself before the concerned Trial Court. The petitioner may file an application for bail with an advance copy to the Public Prosecutor. If such an application is filed, the same shall be dealt with by the Trial Court as early as possible.

This order shall not be taken to be reflection on merits of the matter which shall be gone into independently by the Trial Court.

In case, the petitioner fails to present himself before the Court within seven days, the concerned Police may take appropriate steps in the matter.

Copies of this order be sent to the concerned Police Station as well as to the Jurisdictional Chief Judicial Magistrate.

The Special Leave Petition is accordingly, disposed of.

Pending applications,if any, shall stand disposed of.
