Heard Mr. Rakesh Kailash Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. V.K. Shukla, learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.2 and Mr. Ajay Vikram Singh, learned counsel representing the State of Uttar Pradesh.

Having regard to the circumstances of this case and taking note of order passed by this Court on 11.06.2020 dismissing the Special Leave Petition (Crl.) No. 2188 of 2020 filed by the respondent No.2 (accused) and the pleadings of the parties, the transfer of the criminal case from out of the State of Uttar Pradesh is found to be unjustified. Instead, having regard to the submission made by the State counsel, I deem it appropriate to order for transfer of the Criminal Case No. 1784 of 2019, F.I.R. No 285 of 2018, pending before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Amroha, District Amroha(U.P.) to a competent and equivalent court in Ghaziabad in the same State i.e. Uttar Pradesh. It is ordered accordingly. The case papers be forwarded to the transferee Court without any unnecessary delay.

The transfer petition is disposed of in the above terms.
