O R D E R

1. Having heard Mr. Rakesh Agarwal, the Secretary of the appellants, and learned Additional Solicitor General for the respondents, we are satisfied, that the issue raised by the appellants is of public importance, and therefore needs to be adjudicated on merits.

2. While, we appreciate the reason for the High Court in not entertaining the lis, on account of a dispute between the President and the Secretary of the appellant - Nyaya Bhoomi, we are still of the view, that the issue needs to be debated and effectively determined. We therefore set aside the impugned orders dated 19.4.2010 and 5.5.2010 passed by the High Court, and remit the matter back to the High Court for a consideration of the matter on merits, and in consonance with law.

3. The appeals are allowed in the above terms.
