O R D E R

This petition is by the wife of the respondent seeking transfer of the petition for divorce filed by the respondent and now pending in the Family Court of Bandra, Mumbai, to the Court of the Additional District Judge, Siliguri, District: Darjelling, West Bengal.

Heard the learned counsel on both sides.

The parties were referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre, but the mediation failed.

The petitioner seeks transfer on the ground that she is economically dependent on her parents and it is not possible for her to travel every time such long distances from Siliguri to Mumbai.

The fact that the petitioner is not financially independent, is not seriously disputed. The fact that she is living in Siliguri is also not disputed. The petitioner appears to have filed a case in Siliguri.

Therefore, the transfer petition is allowed.

Accordingly, the proceedings in Petition No. A-480/2018 titled
