



learned counsel and perused the averments, we think that though it would have been ideal and it is indeed expected of all litigants who approach this Court seeking relief that they place all relevant facts in the factual scenario obtaining in the case, finding that there is no regular employment as such, we cannot dismiss the claim which is otherwise just on the ground which is canvassed by the learned counsel for the respondent.

The transfer petition is allowed. Accordingly, case No. A499/2018 titled as *Sarvanjay Ram Singh Gaur v. Swati Sarvanjay Gaur* pending before the Family Court, Thane at Thane, Maharashtra stands transferred to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh.

Taking note of the fact that the petition filed by the respondent-husband is of the year 2018, we would also direct that the transferee Court apart from making efforts of bringing about a settlement between the parties through mediation, dispose of the matter as expeditiously as possible and preferably within 10 months from the date of the production of the copy of this order.
