O R D E R

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband under Sections 13(1)(ia) and 13(1)(ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in the Court of XVI Addl. District Judge, RR District, Malkajgiri, Telangana, to the Court of a competent jurisdiction in North 24 Parganas District, West Bengal.

I have heard learned counsel for both sides and perused the grounds for seeking transfer of the proceedings.

Considering the fact that because of her strained relationship with the respondent-husband, the petitioner at present is residing with her parents at Shyam Nagar, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal, I deem it appropriate to allow this transfer petition.

Consequently, the divorce petition bearing FC OP. No.136 of 2020, titled as "*Sanjib Saha v. Santa Saha*", pending before the Court of XVI Addl. District Judge, RR District, Malkajgiri, Telangana, is transferred to the Family Court, Kolkata, West Bengal. The Presiding Judge, Family Court at Kolkata shall allocate the transferred matter to a Bench of his choice.

The Court of XVI Addl. District Judge, RR District, Malkajgiri, Telangana, is directed to transmit the entire records to the transferee court immediately.

The Registry is also directed to send a copy of this Order forthwith to both the Courts for compliance.

This transfer petition is allowed accordingly.
