O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned counsel appearing for the State of U.P. and carefully perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the bail application of the petitioner.

During the course of hearing, we are informed by the learned counsel appearing for the State of U.P. that charge-sheet has already been filed in the matter and 3 witnesses have already been examined and other witnesses remain to be examined and the next date of hearing before the Trial Court is stated to be on 19-2-2021.

In view of the above, we direct the Trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of four months from the date of communication of this order.

In case trial is not concluded with the stipulated period, as stated above, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the Trial Court for grant of bail.

With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
