O R D E R

1. Learned Attorney General submits that his briefing counsel may be permitted to file an affidavit on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh clarifying the entitlement of three legal heirs of the deceased petitioner to

claim family pension. As per his instructions, the deceased employee had superannuated on 30th June, 2007 and all the three legal heirs were already major and as per Rules they would not be entitled to family pension even if the deceased petitioner is held entitled to pension on a plea that he was entitled to pension in terms of Government Order dated 02nd December, 2000.
