O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having perused the material placed on record, we are not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner-wife for transfer of the cases from Bangalore to Visakhapatnam, essentially for the reason that the criminal case relating to Transfer Petition (Criminal) No.515 of 2022 and pertaining to offences under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code & Sections 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act is pending at Bangalore, where charge-sheet has already been filed.

In the totality of the circumstances, there appears no reason to transfer the said criminal case to any other place. That being the position, we do not find it appropriate to consider transferring the other case i.e., the petition seeking dissolution of marriage filed by the

respondent-husband and pending at Bangalore.

Therefore, these petitions stand dismissed.

However, we leave it open for the parties in making request to the Court concerned for appearance in virtual mode. The prayer, when so made, may be given due consideration.

It goes without saying that the proposition of settlement remains open for the parties.

All pending applications stand disposed of.
