

are now being relied upon to say that even the term of policy issued prior in point of time, ought to be governed by the same interpretation.

Since sum involved in the present matter is only Rs.1 lakh, we do not deem it appropriate to entertain this petition. We therefore, refuse to exercise our jurisdiction under Article 136 (1) of the Constitution of India. In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed. The questions of law, however, are kept open.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
