UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 32 of the Constitution seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus or a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing the respondent to finally number the Admiralty Suit presented by the petitioner, not to raise defect regarding production of the original power of attorney and list the suit before appropriate bench.

Having heard learned senior counsel for the petitioner and carefully perusing the record, we are of the view that the issue involved in the present petition is regarding the production of original power of attorney.

It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that due to the present pandemic situation and due to non-availability of courier services, the original power of attorney could not be produced before the High Court.

In the facts and circumstances of the present case, we direct the petitioner to produce the original power of attorney before the High Court within a period of four weeks from today, failing which the suit may be dismissed.

In the meanwhile, the Registry of the High Court is directed to process the matter and place the same before an appropriate Bench.

With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition stands disposed of.

As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
