O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The present case is one where the appellant has been convicted on circumstantial evidence while the co-accused has been acquitted. The appellant has been in custody for about five years. The appeal has been admitted by the High Court and it appears that in the current situation there is little possibility of the appeal being taken up immediately for hearing.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, we enlarge the appellant on bail on terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Trial Court. We direct that one of the conditions to be imposed by the Trial Court would be the requirement for the appellant to report to the concerned police station on a specified date every month.

The appeal stands disposed of.
