Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the counsel appearing for the respondent.

The special leave petition is filed against the order dated 02.03.2020 passed by the High Court by which the bail application filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. had been rejected. The petitioner is accused in FIR No. 80/2017 under Sections 363, 395, 427, 467, 120B of

IPC.

The High Court had rejected the bail application on the ground that the earlier bail application was rejected on 23.03.2017 and there is no change in the circumstances.

The counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the co-accused has also been granted bail on 05.04.2020 by the High court. He further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for more than three years nine months as on date. Copy of the bail order passed by the High Court granting bail to the co-accused has been brought on record.

We are of the view that the petitioner is also entitled to bail in the facts of the given case. Let the petitioner be released on bail subject to the terms and conditions as fixed by the trial Court.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
