O R D E R

Learned counsel for both the parties submit that parties have settled their disputes in Supreme Court Mediation Centre, New Delhi by way of a settlement agreement dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2018, a copy of which is brought on record. According to them, in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, they seek intervention of this Court under Article 142 of the Constitution of India to waive the statutory period of six months envisaged under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and want divorce by mutual consent dissolving the marriage of the parties. We are not

inclined to grant such relief but in view of the settlement which has been arrived at between the parties before the mediation centre, the parties are at liberty to approach the concerned family court at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu to file an application seeking divorce by mutual consent and the family court, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu is directed to consider and dispose it of as expeditiously as possible.

The report dated 09.01.2018 of mediation centre along with the settlement agreement are taken on record. The parties are directed to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petition stands disposed of. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
