

"The jurisdiction for court case/disputes shall be at Delhi in the Delhi High Court."

The petitioner succeeded before the Single Judge. In an appeal arising therefrom, the order passed by the Single Judge was set-aside by the Division Bench.

The order passed by the Division Bench is presently under challenge.

Mr. Gaurav Agrawal, learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the institution in question had allowed the petitioner to take the Examination. Further, since the excess leave availed by the petitioner was less than 60 days, no prior permission of the NBE was required. In the circumstances, the petitioner appeared at the examination and though she has cleared the examination, as a result of the order passed by the Division Bench, the result now stands invalidated.

Issue notice, returnable on 13.09.2021.

Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.
