Heard Mr. Puneet Jain, learned counsel for the appellant-claimant and Dr. Meera Agarwal, learned counsel on behalf of the respondent no.2-insurer.

In the course of hearing, a suggestion was given to Mr. Jain, learned counsel for the appellant-claimant whether the claim put forth in the claim petition would be satisfied if the appellant is awarded a compensation of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lac). Learned counsel for the appellant-claimant accepted the same. Learned counsel for the respondent no.2-insurer, however, left it to the discretion of the Court.

In view of the aforesaid, it is directed that the respondent no.2-insurer shall deposit the amount before the tribunal within a period of twelve weeks hence failing which the said sum shall carry interest @ 9% p.a. from the date of presentation of application before the tribunal.
