O R D E R

Heard Mr. V. Shekhar, learned senior counsel appearing for the State of Uttar Pradesh. He points out that the correct address of the respondent-Vaibhav @ Amit Saxena could not be furnished within the permitted time, but there was only two days' delay in securing the address. The correct address of the respondent is reflected in paragraph 7 of the application.

Having considered the above, the peremptory order dated 09.12.2019 is recalled after condoning the delay. The criminal appeal is ordered to be restored to its original number.
