3. One of the points argued before the High Court was that looking to the age of the deceased 40% future prospects ought have also been granted. The High Court relying upon *National Insurance Company Limited v. Pranay Sethi and Others*, 2017 (16) SCC 680 has modified the award of the tribunal and granted 40% future prospects as well.

4. In view of the above, we are of the opinion that no case for interference under Article 136 is made out. The special leave petition is dismissed.
