ORDER

1. We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned counsel for the State of State of Maharashtra.

2. Leave granted.

3. This appeal has been filed against the order of the High Court by which bail has been refused to the accused appellant who is accused No.1 in a trial under Section 307/34 IPC, under Section

37(1), 135 of the Bombay Police Act and Section 4(25) of the Arms Act (i.e. C.R. No.156 of 2016 registered with Bhosari Police Station, Pune). The accused appellant has been in custody since 19th May, 2016.

4. We have considered the matter. Having regard to the facts of the case; the period of custody suffered by the accused appellant; and also the fact that the accused No.2, who has also been similarly charged, has already been released on bail we are of the view that the accused appellant should be enlarged on bail. We order accordingly. Therefore, the appellant is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court in connection with C.R. No.156 OF 2016 registered with Bhosari Police Station, Pune.

5. The learned trial Court is free to impose such condition(s) as may be considered appropriate.

6. Consequently, the order of the High Court is set aside and the present appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
