O R D E R

The petitioner is convicted for an offence punishable under section 3(2)(i)(ii),(3)etc. of TADA (P) Act and other Sections of Indian Penal Code including 302, 120B, etc. and sentenced to life imprisonment. Petitioner was however lodged at Central Jail, Varanasi U.P. for the last 22 years from which he was transferred to Bombay Central Prison, Mumbai Maharashtra.

The petitioner's presence is not required in any court in the State of U.P. as of now in any case and Petitioner's presence is also not required in any court in the State of Maharashtra in any case as we have been informed at the Bar.

The petitioner however seeks transfer from Maharashtra Jail to the Central prison at U.P. The State of Maharashtra is silent over the matter in spite of repeated opportunities. All the same the counter affidavit of the State of U.P. has been filed which categorically states that they are not prepared to take the petitioner as he is not required in any case in U.P.

Under these circumstances, the request of the petitioner for transfer from Bombay Central Prison, Mumbai, Maharashtra to the Central Jail, Fatehgarh, Farukhabad, U.P. is presently denied.

In view of above observations, the writ petition stands dismissed.
