

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct that in case the petitioners surrender or are arrested within four weeks, they will be provisionally enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting authority or the Court in seisin of the case, subject to the conditions stipulated in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The petitioners shall appear before the Assistant Director, Directorate of Enforcement, Chennai Zonal Office, 2nd & 3rd Floor, Murugesan Naicker Complex No.84, Greaves Road, Chennai, every day for one week from Monday i.e. 22.05.2017, and thereafter, once in a week for a period of three weeks.

It goes without saying that the petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation and participate in the trial without misusing the privilege of the bail granted to him.

It is submitted by Mr. Shyam Divan, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners, that the passports of the petitioners have already been submitted and they are lying with the custody of the Central Bureau of Investigating (CBI).

With the aforesaid directions, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.

As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory applications, if any, stand disposed of.
