

present SLP has been filed against re-construction of wall and for payment of mesne profits arising from the misconceived adventure of the plaintiff i.e., the petitioner(s) before us. The petitioners failed to establish title over land/wall which was demolished by interim order at their behest and enjoyed the benefit for twenty years. The High court has directed re-construction of wall as a consequence of decree and damages/mesne profits on principles of restitution.

We feel that not only an imprimatur has to be given to the course adopted by the High Court but the petitioners must bear the burden of such misconceived adventure before the court and wastage of judicial time.

We thus dismiss the Special Leave Petition with the cost of Rs.1 lakh to be paid to the respondents for this further prolongation, the impugned order having already been passed as far back as about 10 months ago.

Pending applications stand disposed of.
