The petitioner is aggrieved by an order passed by the learned Registrar of this Court on 28.07.2020, whereby his misc. application was not entertained as it is, in fact, an application to seek review of an order dated 15.07.2020 passed by this Court, dismissing his Special Leave Petition.

The respondent - wife sought dissolution of marriage under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Such petition was allowed by the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court, Ghaziabad on 29.03.2018. The appeal against the said order filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 24.05.2019 by the High Court. The review against the said order was dismissed on 15.05.2020.

Still aggrieved, the petitioner filed a Special Leave Petition, which was dismissed on 15.07.2020, as aforesaid. The

grievance of the petitioner is that the Special Leave Petition was dismissed without hearing him.

Today, we have heard the petitioner at length, for about 20 minutes. We do not find any error in the order passed by this Court as also in the order passed by the High Court affirming the order of dissolution of marriage.

The Misc. Application is, accordingly, dismissed.
