Shri Guru Krishna Kumar, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, has shown us a circular of the High Court which says that the High Court, at present, is taking up only extremely urgent matters; as a

result, this matter is not being listed at all.

Considering the fact that the consequences of the Order passed against the petitioner are of blacklisting it for a period of 10 years, we feel that this is an extremely urgent matter. As a result, the High Court is requested to take up the matter at the earliest.

We have also been shown the fact that there are tenders which are going to open next week, which, as a result of the Order of blacklisting, the petitioner cannot participate in. We are sure the High Court will take heed of this, and, at least, pass interim orders on the writ petition filed by the petitioner.

The special leave petition stands disposed of.
