The respondent who was member of the Trade Tax Tribunal filed a writ petition seeking parity of pay with the other members who were in Government service. The respondent was an advocate before he was appointed as member of the Tribunal. The High Court granted the relief of parity of pay to him with interest @ 6% from the date of his appointment which is of the year 1994. As the writ petition was filed in the year 2001, we modify the order of payment of interest @ 6 % p.a. of the arrears of salary w.e.f. the date of the filing of the writ petition. The petitioner shall pay the arrears of salary payable to the respondent within a period of three months from today.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
