**ORDER**

- 1 On 30 May 2022, an order was passed by the Single Judge of the High Court of Delhi in OMP(I)(COMM.) 298/2021 in terms of which, the respondent has been directed to pay to the petitioner a sum of USD 64,000 converted at the prevailing rate on the date of the order (USD 1 = INR 77.52) after deducting an amount of Rs 10.50 lakhs within a period of four weeks. The order also directs that failing that, the respondent shall be liable to pay interest at the rate of 12% per annum on the sum of USD 64,000 for the period of delay.
- 2 In view of the above order, it is not necessary to entertain the present proceedings, save and except to clarify that the petitioner would be at liberty to execute the order which was passed under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 in accordance with law.

- 3 The Arbitration Petition is disposed of.
- 4 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
