O R D E R

We are of the opinion that the High Court has rightly dismissed the writ petition. The investigation is still on and no chargesheet has been filed. In fact, the Investigating Officer has not even formed any opinion as to whether the dispute is of purely civil nature or the

petitioner has committed offence *prima facie*. Therefore, we dismiss this special leave petition.

However, in the facts and circumstances of the case, we are of the opinion that the petitioner should not be arrested during the investigation. Ordered accordingly. It is, however, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation.

The petitioner is in Canada. Notice can be sent to him by the Investigating Officer at the address which is mentioned in the petition, giving him sufficient time to come to India and participate in the investigation.
