This Transfer Petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of the proceedings in HMA No. 367 of 2020 titled as "Rattan Kumar vs. Poonam" pending before the Family Court, West District, Tis Hazari, Delhi to the Principal judge, Family Court, Rohtak, Haryana.

Office report indicates that notice issued to the sole respondent has been served on him on 19.09.2020. Hence service of notice on the respondent is complete. The record further indicates that stay order passed by this court has also been delivered to the trial court on 21-9-2020. But no one has entered appearance on his behalf so far.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

I am of the considered view that in the interest of justice, transfer of the proceedings, as prayed for, is warranted.

Accordingly, this Transfer Petition is allowed and it is directed that HMA No. 367 of 2020 titled as "Rattan Kumar vs. Poonam" pending before the Family Court, West District, Tis Hazari, Delhi stand transferred to the Principal judge, Family Court, Rohtak, Haryana.

The parties shall be at liberty to apply before the transferee Court for appearing through the video conferencing mode.

The records of the case be transferred to the transferee Court forthwith.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
