UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

This Court, vide order dated 28.02.2020, granted four weeks' time to the appellant to surrender and file proof thereof while dismissing the application for exemption from surrendering. Failure to file proof of surrender within the time granted was to result in dismissal of the appeal without further reference to the Court.

As the appellant did not surrender within the time granted, the appeal stood dismissed.

The applicant - appellant has filed the present application for restoration of the appeal with a delay of 132 days in filing

the same.

Heard learned counsel for the appellant and perused the reasons stated in the applications.

It is stated in the application for restoration that the order dated 28.02.2020 has been complied with and the appellant has been taken into custody.

For the reasons stated in the restoration application and after hearing learned counsel for the applicant - appellant, delay in filing restoration application is condoned and the restoration application is allowed. Consequently, the order dated 28.02.2020 is recalled and the criminal appeal is restored to its original number.
