Leave granted.

Having heard Shri Vikas Singh, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant and Shri Rakesh Dwivedi, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3, and Shri V. Shekhar, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5, and having gone through the entire matter in some detail, we are of the view that, even according to respondent No. 3, the original tender amount being Rs.25.22 crores, admittedly, only a sum of Rs.2.71 crores has been paid to the appellant till date. The differential figure between these two sums be paid to the appellant within a period of four weeks from today. The impugned order of the High Court is set aside. The writ petition is restored to the file to be disposed of on merits.

Considering this is an old case, the High Court is requested to take it up and decide the same within a period

of six months from today.

The payment made by respondent No.3 directly to the appellant within a period of four weeks will be subject to the result of the writ petition.
