O R D E R

This is a petition filed by the wife seeking transfer of the proceedings under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent-husband before the Family Court, Nagpur. The petitioner seeks transfer of the said case to the Family Court at Ranchi, Jharkhand.

We have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the respondent.

Though learned counsel for the respondent would point out that an attempt may be made to bring about a settlement, it is not in dispute that the previous attempts made on two occasions did not yield any result.

It is pointed out to us by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there are two other proceedings - one under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. and another under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act filed by the petitioner seeking dissolution of marriage which are also before the Family Court at Ranchi.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to order transfer as prayed for. The transfer petition shall stand allowed in terms of the prayer. Accordingly, case bearing No. A/1227/2019 titled as *Rohan S/o Ramashankar Trivedi v. Ekta W/o Rohan Trivedi* pending before Family Court Nagpur stand transferred to Family Court, Ranchi, Jharkhand.

The Registry will communicate a copy of this order to the transferor Court for compliance.

We make it clear that the transferee Court will make all efforts to bring about reconciliation/settlement between the parties.
