This Special Leave Petition has been filed against an order passed by the Division Bench of the Kerala High Court condoning the delay of 92 days in filing the appeal before the High Court. The petitioner(s) appeared in person on 12.10.2020, on which day we directed the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee to appoint an advocate from the panel as an Amicus Curiae to appear on behalf of the petitioners.
