O R D E R

The present application has been preferred by M/s Good Living Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd. seeking, inter alia, following relief:

“(i) Extend the time for depositing the second instalment for Rs. 46,79,79,523/- by a period of three months and permit the applicant to deposit second instalment of Rs.46,79,79,523/- by November 18, 2020.”

It is submitted that because of the Lock-down pursuant to Covid-19 Pandemic, the applicant is facing serious difficulties in complying with the directions issued by this Court in its judgment dated 18.02.2020.

Mr. Sanjeev Puri, learned Senior Advocate appearing for respondent No.1 fairly submits that his client has no objection for grant of extension of time as prayed for, provided all other terms emanating from the directions issued by this Court in its judgment dated 18.02.2020 are complied with.

Considering the averments made in the application, in our view, case for extension of time is definitely made out, We,

therefore, allow this application and grant relief as prayed for.

The M.A. is disposed of accordingly.
