O R D E R

- 1 Mr B Adinarayana Rao, Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, submits that the Fixed Deposit Receipts (FDRs) which were required to be furnished in pursuance of the order of the High Court dated 2 September 2020 were in the custody of the Bank. Hence, originally on 10 September 2020, the petitioners furnished photocopies of the FDRs countersigned by the Branch Manager of Canara Bank with an endorsement stating that the originals were with the Bank. Subsequently, on 19 January 2021, the original FDRs were also submitted in terms of the order dated 2 September 2020. Hence, it has been

submitted that though there was a delay, it was not intentional and the interim order passed by the High Court should be restored.

- 4 The counter affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks from the date of service.
