Exemptions are allowed.

We have heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and carefully perused the material available on record.

We find that the High Court vide impugned Order dated 13-1-2021 while dismissing the regular bail application of the petitioner, directed the Trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same within a period of six months, following the

provisions of Section 309 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

In case the Trial Court could not conclude the trial within the time schedule fixed by the High Court, the petitioner would be at liberty to move the High Court for grant of bail.

With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
