**ORDER**

The grievance of the petitioners is that despite the order of this Court dated 23 February 2018, directing consideration of the case for regularization, no steps have been taken despite the representations submitted by the petitioners to the CEO, Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority. Copies of the representations dated 12 March 2018 and 16 June 2018 are annexed as Annexures P-23 and P-24. The order dated 23 February 2018 in SLP(C) No.5925 of 2018 reads as follows:

“Delay condoned.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, we are only inclined to observe that the respondent-authority shall consider the cases of the left out applicants in view of our order dated 06.02.2012 passed in S.L.P.(C)No.5796 of 2012 so that they do not have any grievance with regard to regularisation, if they are covered by the said order of this Court.

Saying so, we part with the case for the present.

If there would be any grievance on the part of the petitioners, they may approach this Court. We are sure, the respondent-authority shall consider their cases in proper perspective.

Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly.”

At this stage, we are of the view that the ends of justice would be met by directing the respondents to consider the representations submitted by the petitioners and to pass a reasoned order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Thereafter, if the petitioners are aggrieved by the action or inaction, as the case may be, it would be open to them to adopt suitable proceedings in accordance with law.

The Contempt Petition is disposed of.
