This appeal arises out of the impugned order dated 30.04.2019 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad in Criminal Misc. Bail Application No. 17695 of 2019, whereby the High Court, while granting bail to the appellant, has imposed a condition to deposit Rs. 22,69,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs and Sixty Nine Thousand) in the account of the complainant.

The order passed by the High Court is modified to the effect that the appellant shall deposit a sum of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs and Fifty Thousand) before the trial court.
