Heard.

We are constrained to dismiss this Writ Petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India because in our view filing of this writ under Article 32 of the Constitution of India is a sheer abuse of process of law.

Admittedly, these very petitioners had filed one Special Leave Petition in respect of the same cause of action and same was dismissed by this Court by order dated 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2018.

In this view of the matter, there was no justification to file this petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India again for the same cause of action.

We, therefore, dismiss this Writ Petition with compensatory costs of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) to be deposited by the petitioners within a month from today for being paid to Supreme Court Legal Services Committee.

Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
