O R D E R

- 1 During the course of the hearing, it has been stated by Mr Vivek Tripathi, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that a petition¹ under Article 226 of the Constitution, where a similar issue is involved, is pending before the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.
- 2 Since a petition is already pending before the High Court, and even otherwise, we see no reason to entertain the petition under Article 32. The petitioners are
