Interlocutory Application Nos. 60149/2022, 60152/2022, 60610/2022 and 60613/2022 stand allowed.

Application for deletion of respondent No. 4 also stands allowed.

In the civil appeal, the parties were referred for mediation. Mediation has turned out to be successful. The mediation appears to be a solution to disputes not only between the parties as originally arrayed but also certain others in view of the comprehensive nature of the settlement.

We have heard Mr. Nikhil Nayyar, learned senior counsel for the appellant, Mr. Gagan Gupta, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and Mr. N. Sai Vinod, learned counsel appearing for the newly impleaded respondents.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, we do not see any reason as to why we should not act on the mediation agreement. Accordingly, the appeal will stand

disposed of in terms of the mediation settlement dated 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022 which will form part of the order. The parties to abide by the terms of the mediation agreement.

It is pointed out by the learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1-3 that there is a freezing of the accounts of the first respondent in the HDFC Bank, 759, ITC Centre, Anna Salia, Chennai-600002, and the State Bank of India, Greams Road Branch, Chennai. According to the terms of the mediation agreement, the freezing of the accounts will be lifted. In view of this, we also direct the HDFC Bank, 759, ITC Centre, Anna Salia, Chennai-600002, and the State Bank of India, Greams Road Branch, Chennai, that the freezing of the account of respondent No.1 shall be lifted.

The appeal is disposed of as above.
