UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel appearing for all the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner's husband is absconding and that the petitioner alleges that she lives separately from her husband since the last two years and has two minor children, we are of the view that she ought to be enlarged on bail, subject to the

usual conditions to be imposed by the trial Court. One of the conditions should be that she has to report to the local Police Station once a week on every Monday starting from the following Monday. Since the Respondent No.2 apprehends that the petitioner may flee to Pakistan, her passport, if any, will also be surrendered to the trial Court.

The impugned order of the High Court is set aside and the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
