**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

- 1 Mr Sushil Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that there was a detailed report by the enquiry officer who came to the conclusion that the charges have been partially proved. Hence, it is urged that in the exercise of judicial review, the Single Judge exceeded the jurisdiction of the Court under Article 226 of the Constitution. The Letters Patent Appeal, it has been urged, has been dismissed without any independent reasoning and the respondent has also been directed to be promoted as Deputy Registrar against vacancies for 1979-1980 and 1980-1981.
- 2 Issue notice, returnable in twelve weeks.
- 3 Counter affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks from the date of service of the notice.
- 4 Pending further orders, there shall be a stay of the operation of the judgment of the Division Bench dated 28 January 2021 and, in consequence, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners on the basis of the order of the Single Judge.
